- (4.1) Conduct the required public hearing on the City of Salina's proposed application for the Kansas Department of Commerce (KDOC) 2023 Community Development Block Grant Housing Rehabilitation, Demolition or Neighborhood Development Grant (CDBG Housing).
- (4.2) Conduct the public hearing and report on Petition No. 4422 filed by Kelly Dunn, Craig Piercy, and Tod Roberg, Members of Stone Lake Development, LLC (petitioner), requesting the vacation of a portion of a 55 ft. wide platted drainage easement located on Lots 18 and 19, Block 4 of the Stone Lake Addition to the City of Salina, Saline County, Kansas to reduce the easement width from 55 ft. to 20 ft. in order to convert it from surface drainage to a storm drainage pipeline and consider approving Ordinance No. 23-11176 ordering said vacation.
